Ms Miller,

These are intense times for me so just expect communications from me as I can do them until the 2022 Pulitzer Prizes are announced.

1) I was called to write the attached book two days ago. It is not finished but I know how to finish it. The Infinite Potential: God

Copy of manuscript attached.

2) When I submitted my 2700 pages of 3300 poems, my complete works 1970 to 2019, for the 2020 Pulitzer Poetry Prize, it was not read nor has it been denied that it was not read.. After the prizes were announced Ms. Canedy was fired within about 6 weeks. Partly because my submission was not considered and I think partly she skewed the prize to Jericho Brown's 100 pages submission about a Black male in search of Black cocks. Her son appears to be gay. And Ms Canedy subordinated all aspects of Peace and WorldPeace to promoting Black Queers. You know Covid, Trumps insurrection, Black Civil Rights, etc Those kinds of critical issues in the world human society right now.

3) I have not been part of any poetry community and read no poetry. Yet just last week I came to the realization that over those years I read a huge amount of religious and spiritual text of which the foundational texts are in a poetic format.

4) I began to research for some understanding why my 3300 poems lost out to 100 poems. I found nothing except what was on the Pulitzer website. And that was the submission needed to have been published between Jan - Oct 1, the prior year unless it was a collection, selection, compilation of multiple years of prior publishing. Nothing else. The unwritten rules have never been published. I am doing that now.

When it came time to submit for the 2021 Pulitzer Poetry Prize in October 2020, I had found no answers. I had written about a 1000 eligible poems. But I did not submit them. I am sure the Pulitzer thought I had disappeared and was out of their hair. I continued my search and did not make a whole lot of progress but I submitted 4 books of about 1400 pages for the 2022 prize anyway.

I had compiled some statistics on the Pulitzer Poetry Prize winners from 2000 - 2020. What I found was that the Prize was significantly skewed primarily to University Professors with a significant list of accolades. Secondary issues were attendance as an undergraduate in an Ivy League university, and a publisher like Copper Canyon Press. I met none of those criteria.

Then in January 2022, I found a book, volume 17 of The Pulitzer Prize Archive by Heinz-Dietrich Fisher of 50 volumes. I also found that Bud Kilment was the keeper of the hard copy of every scrap of paper related to every Pulitzer Prize from the first Pulitzer Prize and that he has worked closely to provide assistance to Mr Fischer in compiling his life work the Pulitzer Archive.

In Volume 17 I found a summary of all the Pulitzer poetry prize deliberations from 1922 to 2000. I made a short hand rendition of those years.

One of the things that surprized me was that over those years, there were an average of only about 50 submissions. And I was shocked to see in the summaries that more than a few poets, Edwin Arlington Robinson, Robert Frost, Edna St. Vincent Millay, and a few other admittedly had the best submission but since they had already won the prize, they did not win in another year. This was later changed. But the idea of the best submission not winning was insane. In what American Contest does the proven best in a contest not win.

It means the Pulitzer Prizes have a long history of arbitrary designation of winners.

5) So what I have done is to create a history based on my research and my personal experience of submissions for the Pulitzer Poetry Prize. From June October 2019 to present.

Everything like this email, I have sent to Pulitzer since was copied to all those listed in the 33rd Annual Edition of Poet's Market 2020 and many university English departments.

Now I dont think you have been made fully aware of this. The announcement of the 2022 prizes is going to be a watershed moment.

My 53 years of being self employed working in insurance, accounting, tax, law and web design with small business owners has taught me that big corporate entities have a philosophy that permeates the entire corporate entity.

So if there was a skewing of the Poetry Prize, all the Prizes have been skewed. And if that is true, the Pulitzer may well experience a fatal blow to its prestige and credibility. And all that is coming to a head in two weeks.

So that is why I gave you a heads-up email last week and why I am continue to expand on that heads-up.

I know nothing about the other prizes except that it seems that some of the major breaking news winners have come from only about 3 publishers.

And Bud Kliment is fully aware of all of it. And if what I suspect is true, then you are going to be the designated goat to take the fall for all of it by virtue of being in charge when the curtain potentially comes crashing down in two weeks.

That is why I suggested you postpone your acceptance of the Adminestership

6) I have no fear of fighting big corporate entities. I fought the Democratic Party of Texas for their corruption in the 2002 Texas Governors race, in which I was a candidate, and became a political prisoner for all of 2008, but as I told the Democratic Party of Texas, if they stayed on their corrupt

path, it would end the dominance of the Democratic Party in Texas since reconstruction. And I was right. Texas went red and all the way to fascism to the supreme cripple now governor Greg Abbott. In Texas in my youth, no Republican had a chance to win any office in Texas. That began to shift with Ann Richards but the 2002 election put the bullet in the head of the Democratic Party in Texas. Tony Sanchez spent \$64 million on the governor's race when \$8 million has been the max. And as I said would happen, he only got 40% of the vote.

7) I have not entered any other poetry contests ever other than the Pulitzer since 1970. I did not publish until 2018. I just kept writing poetry year in and year out.

I wrote 3300 poems between 1970 and October 2019. But since 2018 I figured out what I was doing poetry wise, and I have published another 4000 poems since October 2019. I have no peers as an American or English Poet.

8) I never participated in contests in my 74 years. There are only two prizes in which I have any interest. The Nobel Peace Prize and the Nobel Literature Prize. Neither of which have official entry mechanisms. I have no peers as a poet. I have 7 books that I will enter for the 2023 prize and that will probably grow to 10 by October this year.

7) So why can I write so much. First because I am passionate about writing poetry. But more so I am a high IQ, high energy polymath who has been a lifetime work-a-holic.

8) I have written a book The Third Millennium Second Reformation of Christianity which is going to eclipse the Reformation of Martin Luther 500 years ago.

I have a curriculum for university degrees in Peace. About 6 years ago I sent out emails all over the US to set up a teach peace curriculum of which there are none in any university of the world. WHY? Because increasing the peace in the World Human Society requires change and people hate change more than anything else. These are both agendas bigger than the Pulitzer Prize.

And by the way President Bollinger of Columbia who manages the Pulitzer Prizes received and ignored my Teach Peace email.
