The book advertised was 240 page and the book I received is 228 pages. This would indicate that the two books are not the same. Even though they are touted everywhere as the same.

If you decide to award either of these books, the Pulitzer Prize, you should be very careful.

All over the internet The non existent book The Hill we Climb and other poems is being sold and Call Us What we Carry is being fraudulently delivered.

The Pulitzer knows about this from my prior challenge to these books.

Something is rotten here.

The books are not the same. But I cannot find a copy anywhere on the internet of The Hill we Climb and other poems. No one has these books and yet they are being sold everywhere and Call Us What we carry are being delivered.

You cannot award the Pulitzer Prize to two different books..

The Hill we Climb and other Poems seems to have the 7 digit ISBN 0593465067 published by Penguin Publishing Group 240 numbered pages

and Call us what we Carry was printed by Viking an imprint of Penguin Random House (not the same corporate entity) ISBN 9780593465066 228 numbered pages

The books are billed as the same book different title but the books are not the same. There seems to be a 12 page difference.

Question is what was taken out of The Hill we Climb and other poems

What are Ms. Gorman and her publishers are trying to hide ???
